Instructions to Unit Leadership Applying for PAIA Scholarships:

PAIA Scholarship funds are obtained from the council's annual budget and will allocate a specific amount to fund approved applications.

NOTE: Unit PAIA Scholarship applications are NOT automatically approved. Any amounts approved will be held by the Council and credited towards the units PAIA assessment. Units may apply scholarship amounts to the Discounted Assessment so long as they meet the requirements to "earn" the discount. Scholarship monies being applied towards a unit's annual assessment will be treated as "last" dollars in. This means that the unit is expected to make every effort to fund the PAIA assessment by their own means. Several methods are available, please consult your District Executive.

- Because the number of scholarship applications is unknown, units that wish to have their applications considered must meet the submission deadline of **June 1, 2020**. The earlier the YLTC receives the application following the completion of your units **Family Charitable Giving Effort**, the better.
- Use only the form attached to this letter.
- Please answer every question on the application form. Incomplete forms can cause a delay in the processing or even rejection of the request. The form must be signed by the Unit Leader, the Committee Chair and the Chartered Organization Representative.
- This application should be mailed or delivered directly to **the San Francisco Bay Area Council, Attn: Registrar, 1001 Davis Street, San Leandro, CA 94577**.
- No Unit will receive 100% of their PAIA Assessment as a scholarship. The actual amount will be determined by aggregating the overall number of requests compared to the budget established to provide scholarships.
- Notification to the unit of the amount of the scholarship awarded (if any) will be sent to the Committee Chair in July...if the scholarship amount granted plus the amounts your unit has raised do not equal your PAIA Assessment the unit leadership will need to plan a Fall money earning program to earn the difference.
